

## Lakṣmī sahasranāma stotram

This stotra is from the Skanda Purana where it is being documented as being taught by sage Sanatkumara to a set of 12 sages. Goddess Lakshmi states that even if this stotra is chanted without belief, she would stay forever in their clan.

Another Maha Lakshmi sahasranamam is in Brahma Purana in the chapter of description of Kashmir in the chapter on Hiranyagarbha Hridaya.

One thousand thirty three names are mentioned in the source of this translation, though the text of the sahasranama mentions 1,008 names. Some obvious replications have been merged.

Another peculiarity is that a few prayers to Goddess Lakshmi have been added in the text

of the sahasranama and have also been included in the Namavali.

Saying this Lakshmi, who is a part of Lord Vishnu, disappeared.

iṣṭāpūrtam ca sukṛtam bhāgadheyam ca cintitam  
svam svam sthānam ca bhogam ca vijayam lebhire surāḥ

The devas got their share of the offerings made in Yagas, as well as blessings and the things that they wished as per their relative position and enjoyment and attained victory.

tad etat pravadamy adya lakṣmī nāma sahasrakam  
yoginaḥ paṭhata kṣipram cintitārthān avāpsyatha

Oh sages, I told you just now these one thousand and eight names of Lakshmi which have such great properties. Please read them now for getting all that you want.

gargya uvāca  
sanatkumāro yogīndra ity uktvā sa dayānidhiḥ  
anugr̥hya yayau kṣipram tāms ca dvādaśa yoginaḥ

Telling this the treasure house of mercy, sage Sanatkumara, blessed them and left those twelve sages immediately.

tasmād etad rahasyam ca gopyam japyam prayatnataḥ  
aṣṭamyām ca caturdaśyām navābhyām bhṛgu vāsare  
paurṇamāsyām amāyām ca parva kāle viśeṣataḥ  
japed vā nitya kāryeṣu sarvān kāmān avāpnuyāt

People should try to keep this as secret and read it secretly, and if this is read on eighth or fourteenth or ninth lunar day, or on Friday, new moon day or full moon day or on festival days, or daily, they would get all their desires fulfilled.

iti skanda purāṇe sanatkumāra samhitāyām  
śrī lakṣmī sahasra nāma stotram sāmpūrṇam

Thus ends the thousand names of Goddess Lakshmi occurring in the chapter on Sanatkumara in Skanda Purana.
